Caterpillars are 3 year olds who will enter kindergarten in fall 2019.

In addition to learning vital social skills such as sharing, working with others and being friendly, our Caterpillars focus on letters, numbers and writing ... the essential building blocks to becoming early readers.

All the Details

For both groups, the preschool day begins at 8:15 a.m., but your child may be dropped off as early as 7:20. Cost is \$23.50 per day (breakfast and lunch are included).
